## Checklist for Ocean Grove Graduation Requirements for UC/CSU University Prep

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. Complete “**Graduation Requirements Agreement**” form in 9<sup>th</sup> grade or upon enrollment.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Review “**Suggested Course Plan Schedules for High School Completion**” at <http://www.ogcs.org/guidance/typhsplan/HSSuggSchedules.pdf> using the last column called UC/CSU University Prep for up to date info on UC/CSU college admission for reference.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. Go to <http://www.ogcs.org/handbook/schoolspecific/ag/agindex.html> to find out what *a-g courses* are offered for Ocean Grove Charter School.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. Make sure student begins all appropriate *a-g courses* and other required graduation courses beginning one’s **freshman** year.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Begin “**College/University Prep Endorsement**” form and keep on file.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Have a copy of “**Graduation Requirements Menu**” to know what regular graduation requirements are in addition to the a-g subject requirements.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Be aware of test scores needed to be UC admissions eligibility.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. \*Make a selection of university or universities of interest and contact their admissions department to find out what additional courses are required for admission.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. \***Recommend that student** sign up for *PSAT Examination* on line at <http://www.collegeboard.com/testing/>. (PSAT is to be taken during sophomore year).
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10. \*Recommend that student signs up for *AP Testing* at <http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/ap/reg.html> prior to **March 15th** if interested in taking any exams and check the site for *AP Exam* rules.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 11. \*Recommend that student signs up for *SAT Testing* at <http://www.collegeboard.com/testing/> at the beginning of the **junior year** of high school to allow adequate time to receive test results prior to applying for admission.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12. \*Student should obtain his/her high school GPA from the high school counselor by mid-February of the senior year in order to complete a “**FAFSA**” (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by the March 2<sup>nd</sup> deadline.- **GPA Verification Form is available at**

\_\_\_\_ 13. \*Complete the “FAFSA” (**Free Application for Federal Student Aid**) prior to **March 2<sup>nd</sup>** of the senior year of high school (be aware of the particular university’s admissions department recommendations). <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/> **FAFSA should be submitted for student seeking any type of student aid -- scholarships, grants, etc.)**

\_\_\_\_ 14. \*Apply to the universities of student’s choice after completing all the necessary admissions information as early as spring of **junior year** or beginning of the **senior year** to have the best possible chance of consideration by UC/CSU schools.

\_\_\_\_ 15. Apply for graduation.

\*This process is the responsibility of the parent only, not requiring ES involvement.
