Notes to remember:

- ✓ Most private colleges and other state colleges will accept the UC entrance requirements.
- ✓ UC/CSU requires a minimum of 15 a-g units and recommends a total of 18 A-G units.
- ✓ To meet the recommended 18 unit a-g units, you will need to complete 240 Carnegie units, and add in 3 more a-g courses to your schedule. Consult with your ES.
